Sandler Center Art Gallery hosts “Experienced Synchronicity” by Daniel Kathalynas Beginning March 27, 2017 through May 23, 2017

VIRGINIA BEACH, VA — The Sandler Center Art Gallery is proud to announce that it will host Daniel Kathalynas’s exhibit, “Experienced Synchronicity,” beginning March 27.

Daniel Kathalynas’ method begins in a silent-mind meditation in which he allows the first higher thought that enters his mind to forge the direction of the artwork. He calls this process “First Thought Creation”. Kathalynas has no expected outcome of the work. Essentially, he is just the listener. He looks to observe “Synchronicity” from the largest events to the tiniest detail which informs his art making.

Currently, Daniel Kathalynas is the resident artist of the Norfolk Botanical Garden. Kathalynas exhibited at the US Embassy in Rome, National Art Center in Tokyo, as well as New York City and Washington, DC. He is also a former Artist-In-Residence of the Hermitage Museum in Norfolk, Virginia.

Daniel Kathalynas’s exhibit will be on view in the second and third floor lobbies from March 27 through May 23 during normal operating hours: Monday to Friday, 10am to 6pm, Saturday 10am to 2pm, or during any performance at the Sandler Center.
