A Grand Perspective: Paintings by Russ Marshall *Sandler Center Gallery Hosts Local Artist's Colorful Canvases*

(VIRGINIA BEACH, VA) – Norfolk, Virginia native Russ Marshall is the latest artist to be featured in the Sandler Center Art Gallery. *A Grand Perspective: Paintings by Russ Marshall* will showcase Marshall's enormous colorful canvases and can be seen from August 30 through December 1, 2011 on the second and third floor lobbies of the Sandler Center for the Performing Arts.

Marshall graduated from Maury High School in Norfolk and received his Bachelor of Arts from West Virginia Wesleyan College in 1953. A five foot by six foot canvas, *Homage to Wesleyan*, pays tribute to the college town in the mountains of West Virginia where Marshall made a serious commitment to painting as a life's work.

After completing a tour of duty with the United States Army in Korea, Marshall studied with Lamar Dodd and Howard Thomas at the Fine Arts Graduate School of the University of Georgia. While working toward his Master of Fine Arts in drawing and painting, he taught extension art courses for the University in Gainesville.

The Sandler Center Art Gallery will show paintings depicting the Tiananmen Square Massacre, the Democratic National Convention, the Berlin Philharmonic as well as more traditional flower stills and other inspired subject matter.
