YNot Every Event Registration Begins Now And Ends November 30

Sandler Center for the Performing Arts is home to 10 resident art organizations, including Ballet Virginia International, Symphonicity, Virginia Symphony Orchestra, Tidewater Winds, Virginia Beach Chorale, Virginia Beach Forum, Virginia Arts Festival, Virginia Musical Theatre, Governor’s School for the Arts and Virginia Beach Public Schools. These resident art

organizations presented 169 events last year, bringing the total to 1,424 events at Sandler Center over the past 10 years.
